
SURSORB PAG-10 - Standard Product Specifications

SURSORB PAG-10 is an impregnated pelletized activated carbon specially designed for the adsorption of hydrogen sulphide gas (H₂S) with high adsorption capacity. **SURSORB PAG-10** carbon is capable of removing odour caused by hydrogen sulfide and organic sulfur compounds that are common at wastewater plants, paper mills and industrial plants.

The base material is coconut shell based activated carbon, the extreme porous structure and high specific surface area make it an ideal choice to use as adsorbent in the gas removal application.
